Our Goal is to provide you, our member/guest, with a convenient place to leave your children while you work out. It is important to us that this is not just a daycare, but a **clean, safe, educational, and fun playroom**. Your kids will motivate you to come in and workout so they can come in and play! ☺

Evenings: Monday	4:30-5:30 pm
Tuesday	5:30-6:30 pm
Wednesday	4:30-6:30 pm

Payment Options:

Daily Drop-in:	\$4.00 first child \$1.00 each additional family member
Monthly Unlimited:	\$35.00 first child \$ 5.00 each additional family member
Prepay Packages:	\$40.00 10 visits \$ 1.00 each additional family member-each visit

**Family members must reside at the same address.

Playroom Policies:

The playroom is available to children 6 weeks - 11 years

Maximum 2 infants under 6 months of age

No more than 9 children per one attendant at one time

- *Whenever possible a second employee will be asked to assist in the playroom if the maximum allowed amount is exceeded for one attendant. We will always do our best to ensure the playroom is available to all guests*

Please feed your child prior to entering the playroom

Please take your child potty or change them before entering the playroom

Parents will be notified if a child needs to use the restroom/be changed

Parents will be notified if a child is inconsolable, injured, or sick

The playroom is only available during set hours and only while parents are in the fitness center

No children of any age can be left unattended in the workout area

A small snack will be provided whenever possible

- (If you would like to bring a snack for your child, please make sure there is enough to share with other children, and make sure it does not contain common allergens.)

Water will be provided to all children

Please do not bring toys from home

Each child needs to be signed in and out of the playroom each visit by the parent/legal guardian

- (Date, am/pm, name, age, parent name, time in & out, initial in & out, in class or workout?)

Grandparents are allowed to bring in children as long as they have written permission from the parent

- (The grandparent & parents both need to fill out the parental paperwork.)

Parents/grandparents/legal guardians can bring their children into the playroom (no other relations)

If children are sick please LEAVE THEM HOME!!!

- (Green snot, coughs, fever, soar throat, vomiting, diarrhea, etc.)

- **If your child comes into the playroom while they are sick, you will be notified to take them out immediately.**

- *To ensure the playroom is not closed due to illness, please make sure sick children are not coming being brought in to play. (If they are home from school please keep them home.)*
- (If the attendant/attendant's child is sick they are also required to stay home. Whenever possible a qualified substitute childcare attendant will be available to care for your child. In the rare event that no one is available to fill-in, the playroom will be closed. We will make every effort to notify all the parents that might be affected by this closure.)

TOYS:

All things in the playroom are cleaned and sanitized on a regular basis. Toys and the playroom are checked regularly for potential hazards.

Baby toys are kept separate from other toys to ensure safety and cleanliness since these go in little mouths.

SAFETY & SECURITY:

For the security of the children and the convenience of the parents, a security camera has been installed in the playroom. The camera is monitored at all times at the front desk. Parents are able to check the monitor at any time at the front desk to ensure their children are safe and happy.

The playroom and the front desk have radios to communicate if needed. If your child is hurt, sick, or inconsolable, disruptive, or needs to be changed or use the restroom, you will be notified by the front desk personnel.

PLAYROOM RULES:

- ✓ Respect others feelings, bodies, and space around them
- ✓ Do not tease, only use kind words
- ✓ Treat others as you want others to treat you
- ✓ Be respectful of the toys and the playroom
- ✓ One project per visit
- ✓ The closets are locked and off limits to children
- ✓ Children are not to be outside the playroom without a supervising adult
- ✓ Snacks and drinks at the table only
- ✓ Anything behind the white line is off limits
- ✓ Only the playroom attendant is allowed to pick up/hold children
- ✓ No bare feet in the playroom – socks are okay
- ✓ Cover mouth and nose when sneezing or coughing
- ✓ No toys from home
- ✓ No violence/threat of violence/or weapons
- ✓ It is very important to have fun
- ✓ Include other playroom friends in games/play
- ✓ Use words
- ✓ No taking toys away from others

CONFLICT RESOLUTION:

- ✓ Positive reinforcement
- ✓ Prevention
- ✓ Distract
- ✓ Redirect
- ✓ Separation from conflict
- ✓ Object in time-out
- ✓ Time-out
- ✓ Parent intervention
